Key Purpose

Planning and teaching lessons to production arts students and marking their work.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- You will be responsible for supporting the development and progression of students in UAL Level 3 Diploma and Extended Diploma in Production Arts.
- Planning exciting and industry relevant lessons.
- Marking a share of the student's project work.
- Ensuring the students are achieving to their full potential by keeping track of their attendance and punctuality.
- Working as part of a dynamic team to ensure the student experience is second to none.
- Liaising with different departments to achieve relevant industry experience of collaborative practice and process.
- Preparing equipment, materials and setting up equipment and other resources for the classroom lessons.
- Work flexible hours between 9am and 7pm on an 'as needed' basis.
- Successful candidate will have to slot in quickly, it is extremely desirable they have strong passion for teaching and learning.
- Ensuring the health and safety of staff, students and visitors to the workshops and classrooms.
- Participating in the maintenance of satisfactory standards of safety and security in accordance with college policy and relevant legislations.
- Keeping up to date with health & safety requirements.
- Other appropriate teaching and technical duties as requested by the Centre management team. This may involve work in any area of the department and on any of the college sites.

- Currently working within the music industry as a professional practitioner.
